### Early arrivals

Supervision of students starts at 9am. If you have work arrangements that sometimes necessitate your children coming before 9am on any day, this **MUST** be arranged with Mrs Latta **BEFORE** the date. Parents will need to sign documentation that outlines children will sit outside the office until the 9am bell rings.

These forms will be sent home with your child once you have had a conversation with Mrs Latta. **Please note that this is for extreme cases only. It is not a before school care service.**

Please note the **FIXED EQUIPMENT** is not to be used by any children, including pre-schoolers, before or after school as it is not being supervised by a teacher during these periods.

Our school uniform has been chosen by the wider school community through surveys and focus groups in 2009/2010. It is expected that students will wear school uniform every day. No variations to the designated uniform are acceptable attire.

## Other Acceptable Uniform Items- These can be purchased from Target, Big W, K-Mart or Best and Less.



Long sleeved t-shirts can be worn under school shirts. Only acceptable colours are RED, NAVY OR WHITE



Navy tights can be worn by girls under their culottes. Younger girls can wear NAVY leggings under their culottes. **No other colour, including BLACK, are acceptable.**

**Leggings worn without culottes is not acceptable attire**



Track pants are acceptable in colder weather- Royal or Navy blue has been chosen as it matches our polar fleece tops



BLACK joggers are the preferred shoe. This allows for children to be active every day in the playground while keeping their feet safe from cuts and abrasions. Black laces are part of our uniform.

Year 6 students can wear their Year 6 t-shirts at all events.
