### Stage 1 Excursion

The permission note and payment for the stage 1 excursion to Rocky Creek Dam is due **this Wednesday the 17**<sup>th</sup> **of October.** Late notes and payments will not be accepted after this date. ### **Child Protection Lessons**

Child Protection lessons start this week. Lessons 1 and 4 will be taught by class teachers. Lessons 2 & 3 are being taught by staff from Y-PEP which is funded by NSW Government and Department of Education. This programs is aligned to the current health, Personal Development & Physical Education Syllabus. Topics covered are:

**Lesson 1:** Sense of Self- Similarities and differences, Introduction to the UN Rights of a Child.

**Lesson 2:** Power in Relationships-Rights and responsibilities, trusted adults, power in relationships

**Lesson 3:** Recognising Abuse-Warning signs, body parts, types of abuse- physical, sexual and

emotional, safe and unsafe touching and secrets.

**Lesson 4:** Protective Strategies-Responding to risk, NO GO TELL, communication

### Parking

Please note that with the wet weather it is very easy to get bogged when parking on the grass area at the front of the school. We urge you to park in the surrounding streets instead. The full bus bay area must be kept vacant before and after school as the buses need this area to turn safely.

## Early leaving and late arrivals

Any changes to afternoon pick up need to be made by 1.45pm. This allows time for teachers to be informed and messages to get to children. Any messages after this time will be communicated through our PA system AFTER the 3.25 bell. Teachers on bus duty will be aware of any changes.

No child will be called from classes after 3pm unless it is an absolute emergency - appointments are not classed as emergencies. Parents will not be able to collect children from classes.

By all means make arrangements with other parents to collect your child but please ensure the class teacher is notified in advance and avoid changing plans as this tends to cause confusion at 3.25pm. If the pickup person is not here to collect their child in the afternoon, the child must be brought to the office before you offer to take them as staff may already be aware of the arrangements in place.

The Home School Liaison Officer (HSLO) regularly checks our rolls. Frequent partial absences can result in HSLO intervention.

We appreciate your ongoing support in this matter.
