12:00 – K S & 1 H


1:00 – 1 / 2 S & 2 L

## School Uniform

At last week's P & C meeting our uniform was a topic of conversation in light of the changes to the Department of Education Uniform Policy. Our uniform will reflect the policy by changing 'boys' and 'girls' to 'acceptable'.

The short blue netball skirts are NOT part of our uniform. These and multi coloured jumpers/jackets should not be worn to school.

We believe that by choosing our school, you are choosing to wear our uniform.

### Hat and Hair

Blue brimmed hats are part of our uniform. They should be worn at all times when children leave their classrooms. Strings on hats can pose a risk when playing on the fixed equipment. As such, strings can be removed by parents or child can remove hats ONLY WHEN AT THE EQUIPMENT.

All long hair should be tied back at all times in a manner that allows hats to be worn properly.

## Signing Students in at office

A reminder that if your child is late, early or out of class for a period of time then they **must** be signed in/out at the office by an adult. A "Pass" ticket will be given to the student when signing in late so that their teacher knows that a parent or adult has signed them in at the office.

## Changes to afternoon pick-up

Most days there is an overabundance of parents calling about changed afternoon pick-ups and/or parents arriving at the office to pick up children.

We are requesting that you help us streamline this with a decision being made in the morning before school if a change is needed for an appointment or other family reason so you can discuss this with your child and send a note for the teacher.

**These changes are being enforced for the safety of your children.**

**Confusion at 3:25pm as to what last minute arrangements have been made, and for classroom teachers to know who is picking up children or which bus they are to go on is not ideal for student safety.** Please remember we are managing almost 100 families and their needs. We really hope you can help us in our efforts to safeguard everyone's learning and wellbeing.
