### Memorandum of Understanding

**Please note the following as our school procedures need to be reiterated.**

Any changes to afternoon pick up need to be **made by 1.45pm**. This allows time for teachers to be informed and messages to get to children. Any messages after this time will be communicated through our PA system AFTER the 3.25 bell. Teachers on bus duty will be aware of any changes.

**No child will be called from classes after 3pm** unless it is an absolute emergency - appointments are not classed as emergencies. Parents will not be able to collect children from classes.

By all means make arrangements with other parents to collect your child - but please ensure the class teacher is notified in advance and avoid changing plans as this tends to cause confusion at 3.25pm. If the pickup person is not

here to collect their child in the afternoon, the child must be brought to the office before you offer to take them as staff may already be aware of the arrangements in place.

The Home School Liaison Officer (HSLO) regularly checks our rolls. Frequent partial absences can result in HSLO intervention.

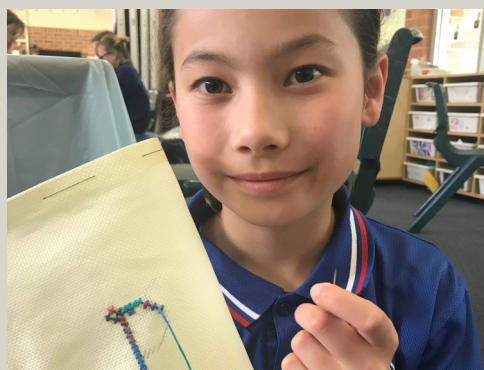

## Child Protection Lessons

All classes K-6 will be participating in Child Protection Lessons next term. These will run over four weeks. Lessons 1 and 4 will be taught by class teachers and lessons 2 and 3 will be taught by staff from North Coast/New England Y-PEP (Child Protection Education) Program.

This program has been approved by Department of Education and is aligned to the NESA PDHPE Syllabus focusing on the three key themes; Recognising Abuse, Power in Relationships and Protective Strategies. The aim of the Y-PEP program is to strengthen the existing child protection education curriculum outcomes delivered by school teachers.

What are the outcomes?

As a result of this program, children and young people will have;

- An increased awareness of safe and respectful relationships

- An increased knowledge and understanding of rights and responsibilities in relationships

- Increased their skills in recognising, assessing risk and responding to unsafe situations.

The workshops are highly interactive to allow students to use multiple areas of learning. The experienced and professional facilitators deliver the workshops suitable for varying levels of skills and to create age appropriate and engaging content for children to feel safe.

Topics covered;

**Lesson 1:** Sense of Self- Similarities and differences, Introduction to the UN Rights of a Child.

**Lesson 2:** Power in Relationships- Rights and responsibilities, trusted adults, power in relationships

**Lesson 3:** Recognising Abuse- Warning signs, body parts, types of abuse- physical, sexual and emotional, safe and unsafe touching and secrets

**Lesson 4:** Protective Strategies- Responding to risk, NO GO TELL, communication
