We have a new student, Lottie, joining KH and she has a suppressed immune system, meaning she has a lower immunity and cannot fight infections in the normal way.

She has had a condition that required chemotherapy.

Viruses that cause measles, chickenpox and shingles could make Lottie extremely unwell. Therefore we would be grateful if you would contact the school immediately if your child, regardless of what class they are in, was found to have one of these illnesses. If we know that there has been exposure to measles, chickenpox or shingles, medicine can be given to lessen the side effects of such an infection to Lottie. This medicine does need to be given as soon as possible after the contact has taken place.

We thank you for your understanding and are looking forward to welcoming Lottie to our school community.
