District Cross Country

Our district Cross Country carnival is being held here this Friday 17th May 2019. This will affect your morning drop off as we are expecting 500 extra people on our site, so if at all possible can students please catch the bus on Friday morning to ease the congestion around drop off time. If driving is a necessity please consider a 'kiss and go' drop off at the front of the school. Just a reminder about parking, no cars can enter or leave the school grounds during the races. At 9.45am there will be a block at the front entrance. Please don't block anyone's drive way when parking. The road between the school and Fredericks Lane (near the rainforest entrance) is a private road - please do not park there at all. Both sets of fixed equipment will be out of bounds on this day as it will not be supervised by staff during the carnival. (this includes preschool use as well) Some of our 3-6 non-runners may be watching the carnival. It would be great if you could provide something for them to sit on.

NOTE: The district carnival and top shop is for children who turn 8 or older this year and who have qualified at our recent school Cross Country. All other children will have normal lessons on the day.

Social Media Accounts

At our school, we have children as young as 8 who have Instagram and other social media accounts. While this is primarily an issue for parents to deal with, the school will step in when what happens on line encroaches on our daily school life. Instagram seems to be the main social media app used at present. This is designed for 13+ years of age. Below are taken directly from the Terms & Conditions of Instagram.

Your Commitment to Instagram

We ask:

1. Don't park in driveways or on front lawns
2. Drive 30-40kph in surrounding streets as there is a lot of foot traffic
3. Park in the direction of traffic
4. Before you park, check that there is still room for cars to use the road. In some areas, you won't have room to park on both sides of the road.
5. Don't park on corners as this blocks vision for cars (and you can be booked for this)
