### Early pick-ups from school

**The following school procedures need to be reiterated.**

Any changes to afternoon pick up need to be **made by 1.30pm**. This allows time for teachers to be informed and messages to get to children. Any messages after this time will be communicated through our PA

system AFTER the 3.25 bell. Teachers on bus duty will be aware of any changes.

**No child will be called from classes after 3pm** unless it is an absolute emergency - appointments are not classed as emergencies and should be notified to school before 1:30pm or preferably with a note to the teacher. Parents will not be able to collect children from classes.

By all means make arrangements with other parents to collect your child - but please ensure the class teacher is notified in advance and avoid changing plans as this tends to cause confusion at 3.25pm. If the pickup person is not here to collect their child in the afternoon, the child must be brought to the office before you offer to take them as staff may already be aware of the arrangements in place.

**The Home School Liaison Officer (HSLO) regularly checks our rolls. Frequent partial absences can result in HSLO intervention.**

No students before 9am

A reminder that under no circumstances should children be onsite before 9am unless in the direct supervision of their parent. Playground duty starts at 9am. While we did offer a service in 2018, we found many of the children either were unnecessarily here early or would not follow safety instructions from the teachers. While we may have before and after school care starting in term 3, you need to make other arrangements if you start work too early to be here from 9am. If your child is on site before 9am they will receive a reminder letter to give to their parents.

Uniforms

Have you written your child’s name on ALL items of clothing? This time of year we end up with mountains of jumpers and vests in lost property. We would much prefer to reconnect the lost item with their owner. As it gets colder, children can wear longer pants (navy) or track pants over their shorts (navy or royal blue). All children can wear long sleeve t-shirts under their uniform (red, white, royal blue or navy only) and girls can wear navy tights. The School Locker may not have long pants for sale. They were not high selling items when the uniforms were sold through the school, and were cheaper for parents to buy at Target or Big W. The short blue netball skirts that have appeared in the school are **NOT** part of our uniform. Only the red short/skirt sports combination is

allowed. We suggest you have navy socks for your children. They are much easier to clean than white socks. A reminder also that school shoes should be predominantly BLACK, with black laces.
