Athletics Carnival Guidelines

There will not be any finals. Final places will be awarded on TIMES. A child may get a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in THEIR HEAT, but there may be a quicker heat which will determine who goes to District.

Our school carnival is a lead up to the District Carnival. The District sets the number of entries allowed in each event as well as qualifying heights and distances. We must meet these criteria. Children who place at our carnival do NOT automatically progress to District. Our school team will be announced after the field events have been completed. Children MUST WEAR SHOES to compete. Children who represent the school at District must wear school uniform.

An event will not be rerun for a child who is away on the day of the School Carnival event. When school events clash with Department of Education

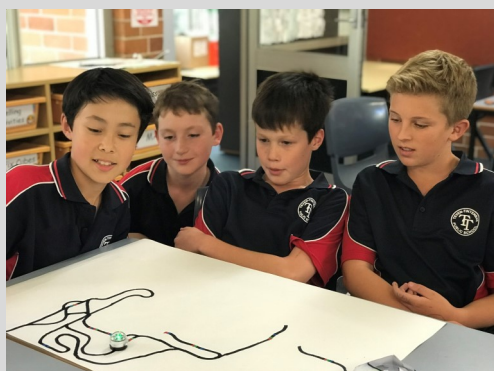

Emergency Drill Practice

We are required to have two emergency evacuation or lockdown practices each year. Over the coming weeks we will be having an emergency drill practice.

Please help us by explaining to your children that this is just pretend, but we have to do it seriously so we know what to take if we had a real emergency.

Teachers will be preparing children in class. The time and date will be advised in next week's newsletter.

On and off the bus safely

Your child is most at risk just after getting off the bus. To reduce this risk, meet your child at the bus stop, never on the opposite side of the road.

At the bus stop, hold hands and stand with your child, well away from the passing traffic. Never wait close to the kerb.

Wait until the bus has driven off before choosing the safest place to cross the road. Then follow the usual road crossing procedures with your child.

- STOP! One step back from the kerb.
- LOOK! For traffic to your right, left and right again.

•LISTEN! For the sounds of approaching traffic.

•THINK! Whether it is safe to cross.

Teach your child to turn their head in both directions to look and listen for traffic as they cross the road.

Remember, until your child turns 10, hold your child's hand whenever you cross the road.

At school, your child will learn about road safety as part of Personal Development, Health and Physical Education. Help them learn the bus safety messages by using them and sharing them whenever you are out and about on a bus.

Students in Early Stage 1 to Stage 3

•Wait until the bus has gone, then use a safe place to cross the road

•Hold an adult's hand when you cross the road

•Use a safe place to cross

•Stop! Look! Listen! Think! Every time you cross the road
