Student Academic Reports

These will be in school bags this Wednesday. If you have requested a report as a non-custodial parent, these will be available at the office or sent home in the method you have requested.

Absences are reported in the following way: Whole day absences, the full day

equivalent of partial absences and the overall percentage of time missed in this semester.

An example how this might be reported: A child (not real) had 5 days absence- this would give an overall percentage of 95%. This same child has been late by a few minutes each morning, and often gets picked up early. As this partial time out of class totals to 10 school days (60 hours) the child now has a percentage of 85%.

When a pattern of absence falls below 80%, the school is obliged to refer this to the Home School Liaison Officer and/or make a referral to FACS for educational neglect.

We encourage you to review the attendance patterns of your children. Absences from school, including partial absences, should only be for sick leave, school approved family holidays, family emergencies and specialist doctor appointments (non GP).

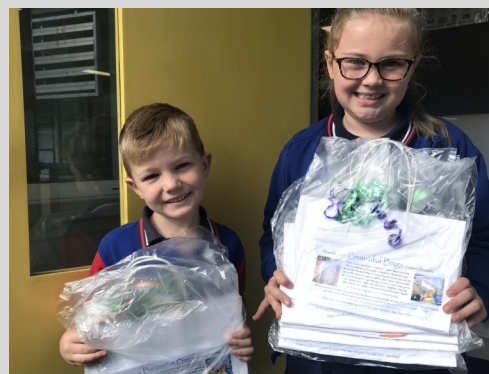

Term 2 Concert

Our wet weather plan is to hold the concert in the 5/6 classrooms. This would mean the children only come in when it is their turn to perform, leaving room for parents to sit and watch.

The concert starts at 2pm and should be finished by 3pm. You can park in the bus bay as long as you have moved from the bus parking area by 3.15pm.

Afternoon Pick Up Line

Did You Know?

1. You can use the pickup line every afternoon.
2. You do not need to register.
3. You do not need to get out of your car- so no getting wet.
4. The line moves quicker than you think.
5. Executive staff stay out the front of the school until the last child is collected.

We ask that you:

1. Make sure your children know to wait at front of school for pick up.
2. You will see a line of cars at the front of the school. Please wait your turn.
3. Don't double-park in the bus bay- this is unsafe for our children. Please wait your turn in the line.

This is our preferred option if picking up your children. Once the bus has parked, you can drive in and form a line behind it. Then we have about 10 minutes until the second bus. Alternatively, you can wait until 3.35 and pick your child/ren up in the bus bay then.

Ethics Classes Volunteers Needed!!

At TTPS we have over 60 children currently enrolled in Ethics classes and are seeking volunteers so that ethics classes are available for all families who have requested them.

Ethics teachers receive full training by Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the ethics program.

Training consists of a two day workshop and short online modules. Lesson materials are provided. Suitable volunteers have an interest in children's education and development of critical thinking skills. Classes are held from 2pm to 3pm every Tuesday just before assembly.

Children discuss topic such as:

- imagining how others feel
- how do we treat living things?
- what is laziness?
- how do we disagree in a respectful way?
- fairness
