Uniform

As we move into cooler weather in the morning, please ensure all clothing belonging to your child is clearly labelled. Jumpers and hats are items that are misplaced often. If the name is on them they can be quickly returned to the students. If there are no names, clothing is hung in the lost property area between the Year 4/5 and 5/6 room. Please check regularly if you are missing an item.

Late to school

It is a LEGAL REQUIREMENT that an adult sign children in to school when they are late in the morning, even if your child is only 2 minutes late. If you do not attend with your child, it will automatically be classified as an unexplained absence and may result in a referral to the Home School Liaison Officer (HSLO).

Seasons for Growth

Learning to live with change and loss
Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in our lives.
At Teven-Tintenbar Public school we recognise that when changes occur in families through death, separation, divorce, moving and related circumstances, young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively. We are therefore offering a very successful education program called Seasons for Growth which will commence from Week 3.

This program is facilitated in small groups and is based on research which highlights the importance of social support and the need the practise new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problem-solving, decision-making, effective communication and support networks.

Every family will receive a notice in the near future with more details about the Seasons for Growth program. If you think your son or daughter would benefit from Seasons for Growth we would encourage you to talk to him/her about participating in the program.

We are starting the process of setting up for Kinder 2020. If you have a child due to start Kinder in 2020 could you please let the office know as soon as possible so we can ensure places are held for them. We require a copy of their birth certificate so we can begin the paperwork.

Student Attendance

Our rolls are marked electronically. Teachers can only access rolls for 7 days after the start of an absence. We require notes (either handwritten or emailed) before the 7th day after an absence starts. From the 8th day, absences are classed as UNEXPLAINED. Frequent unexplained absences will result in a referral to the Home-School Liaison Officer, as will frequent lateness and early pickups.
