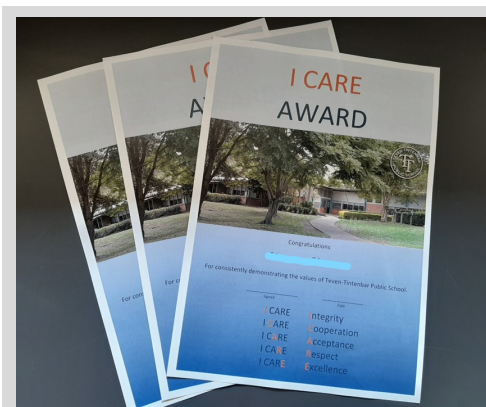

## Parent-Teacher Interviews 2020
